Please expect to fulfill these Roles if you compete in the Pageants

- Each queen will be assigned specific events at which she **MUST BE PRESENT** during Fair week of February 2 thru February 11, 2007.

Awards: Along with the title of Collier County Fair Queen/King, winners in each age division will receive a Crown, Monogrammed Banner, & Flowers. Miss division winners will also win a scholarship: Queen: \$500, First Runner-Up: \$250. All queens and king also have a special invitation to ride in all Collier County parades throughout the upcoming year!

Bonus Awards: This is an exciting part of the competition and is included in registration fees! A special award will be given to the constant in each age group with the Best Hair, Best Dressed, and Best Smile!

Attire: Sunday, Easter, Prom, Party, Flower girl or Pageant Dresses. Hair and makeup should be age appropriate. Arrive in a near ready state due to limited dressing room facilities. No electrical outlets available.

Talent Competition

Talent may consist of singing, dancing, poetry reading, sign language, etc. No piano will be provided. This competition is judged on stage presence, facial expressions and showmanship; originality and difficulty of routine. Props are allowed. The Director, Tiffany Sawyer, **MUST APPROVE** talent performances prior to pageant.

- **Humorous/Dramatic Interpretation:**

Contestants can perform a humorous or dramatic monologue or a humorous/dramatic poetry or prose reading. Costuming is important! Props encouraged.

- **Commercial Performance:**

Choose your favorite product from the store or create your own product and sell it to the audience! This should be less than one minute. Props encouraged. The more you can engage the audience, the better you'll do!

Rules and Regulations

1. All contestants must be residents of Collier County. Must have proof of residency: copy of utility bill with parents' name and address.
2. Age requirements are as follows: **Prince & Princess** – open to boys and girls, must be between the ages of 4 and no older than 6 years by December 31, 2006. **Little Miss** – must be between the ages of 7 years and no older than 11 years by December 31, 2006. **Junior Miss** – must be between the ages of 12 years and no older than 15 years by December 31, 2006. **Miss** – must be between the ages of 16 years and no older than 21 years by December 31, 2006. **Please provide a copy of birth certificate or certified copy at registration.**
3. A non-refundable registration/sponsor fee of \$100.00 is required of each contestant. Sponsors may come from parents, relatives, businesses, etc. Must have a certified check or cash.
4. Contestants in the **Prince & Princess** pageant will be judged in dressy attire (but no pageant wear and no makeup) and will be judged on introduction, good looks, personality, selection of dress, and overall appearance.
5. Contestants in the **Little Miss** pageant will be judged in a dressy dress (but no pageant wear) and will be judged on introduction, beauty, poise, personality, selection of dress, and overall appearance.
6. Contestants in the **Junior Miss** pageant will be judged in a long or short pageant gown and will be judged on beauty, poise, personality, and selection of dress, overall appearance, and thirty-second introductions.
7. Contestants in the **Miss** pageant will be judged in a talent competition and a floor length pageant gown. They will be judged on beauty, poise, personality, and selection of outfits, overall appearance, and thirty-second introduction. Talent Competition will be judged on stage presence, facial expressions and showmanship; originality and difficulty of routine
8. Only one person may be backstage with contestants during the contest.
9. Registration will be available on November 1, 2006 in the Collier County Fair Office. The first twenty applications with sponsor fee will be accepted for each division. Final Registration for all age divisions will be February 3, 2007 from 11:00 a.m.-12:00 noon.
10. All contestants are required to attend the rehearsal on Saturday, February 3, 2007 at the Collier County Fair Grounds. The rehearsal times are as follows: **Prince & Princess and Little Miss** – 11:30 a.m.; **Junior Miss & Miss** – 10:00 a.m. If for some reason a contestant cannot attend rehearsal, special permission must be obtained from the pageant director.
11. The Pageants for all age divisions will be held February 3, 2007 as follows: **Tiny Miss** – 12:00 noon; **Little Miss** – 12:30 p.m.; **Junior Miss** – 1:00 p.m.; **Miss** – 2:00 p.m. All contestants need to arrive dressed and ready 30 minutes prior to the start time of their pageant.
12. We will crown all age divisions after every two age groups have competed
13. All division winners will ride on the Collier County Fair Float in county parades during her reign. Contestants may also be asked to attend other local events in Collier County.
14. All division winners will be expected to crown the new queens in 2008.
15. All division winners will only be representatives of the Collier County Fair. No sashes or crowns will be worn during the other events outside of the Collier County Fair events.
16. The CC Fair Pageant committee has permission to use my/my child's photographs, voice, and service gratis in connection with the Pageant, including any subsequent recorded or timed excerpts of the pageant for public relations purposes.

Rehearsals for contestants will be held at the Fairgrounds Stage at the following times on Saturday, February 3, 2007:

Junior Miss (Ages 12-15 yrs)	10:00 a.m.
Little Miss (Ages 7-11 yrs)	11:30 a.m.
Prince & Princess (Ages 4-6 yrs)	11:30 a.m.

- All contestants will draw their number of appearance at rehearsal.
- Dressing room is provided but limited to contestant and ONE PARENT OR HELPER.
